


Worker Employment Status

California Labor Code §2750.5

- If a person performs services that; requires a license pursuant to Chapter 9 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code
- Business and Professions Code
 and that person does not have that license,
- that person is considered an employee











Special Rules Classifications

5146 - Cabinetry & Trim N.O.C. 5107 - Doors & Windows

Both class codes specifically require that no framing or structural work be done in connection with the same job or project location.





Supervisors

Supervisors that are directly responsible for the day-to-day operations would generally be classified the same as those they are supervising.

5606 – Executive Level Supervisor

- all construction operations subcontracted to licensed contractors and no payroll developed under any construction classification
- two levels of supervision between the workers performing the actual labor



Premium Audit

At the end of your policy period State Fund conducts an audit to review your payroll and ensure that you are charged the correct amount of premium for the policy term.

Premium audits also update any details that may affect coverage and rates.




Audit Requirements


It's Part of Your Policy

- State Fund conducts voluntary audits through payroll reporting requirements





- Training & Inspection Records

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
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
